**APPLICATION FOR INFORMAL PROBATE OF  
WILL AND APPOINTMENT OF PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE**

Guy Markley Naylor, Applicant, states:

1. Applicant is the son of Elizabeth Williams Naylor, deceased, and is, therefore, a person interested in the settlement of the Estate of Decedent, is not disqualified to serve as personal representative, is nominated in Decedent's Last Will and Testament to serve as the first personal representative of her Estate, and there are no other persons having prior right to appointment.
2. Elizabeth Williams Naylor died on November 24, 2011, at the age of eighty-five (85) years. At the time of her death, Decedent was domiciled in, Albuquerque, Bernalillo County, New Mexico, thus giving rise to venue.
3. Decedent's Last Will and Testament filed herewith is a "pour-over" Will, and the primary beneficiary under said Will is the ELIZABETH WILLIAMS NAYLOR PROTECTIVE LIVING TRUST u/a dated May 24, 2011. Guy Markley Naylor and Dale

W. Gunn, M.D., are the Co-Trustees of said Trust. The Co-Trustee's resided in Bernalillo County, New Mexico, or have otherwise submitted to the jurisdiction and venue of this Court.

- B. The Applicant be informally appointed as Personal Representative, to serve without bond, in an unsupervised administration;

- C. That Letters Testamentary be issued to Applicant upon his acceptance;

D. Such other and further orders be entered as this Court deems proper.



**ORDER FOR INFORMAL PROBATE OF WILL  
AND APPOINTMENT OF PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE**

Guy Markley Naylor, by and through his attorney, F. Vaughn Thomas, has filed an Application for Informal Probate of the Last Will and Testament of Elizabeth Williams Naylor, Deceased, and for informal appointment as the Personal Representative of the Decedent's Estate, and based on the statements in the Application, the Court FINDS:

1. The Application for Informal Probate of Will and for Informal Appointment of Personal Representative is complete.
2. The Applicant has made oath or affirmation that the statements contained in the application are true to the best of Applicant's knowledge and belief.
3. The Applicant is an interested person as defined by the laws of the State of New Mexico.
4. Jurisdiction in this estate, proceeding, and subject matter is proper.
5. Venue is proper because the Decedent's domicile at the time of death was Albuquerque, Bernalillo, New Mexico.

6. An original, duly executed and apparently unrevoked Will of the Decedent is in the possession of this Court, was properly executed and is valid.

7. Any notice required by the laws of this State has been given.

8. The Applicant is nominated in the Last Will and Testament of Decedent as the Personal Representative, to serve without bond, is qualified to act as the Personal Representative of the Decedent, and has priority entitling Applicant to the appointment.

9. No Personal Representative has been appointed in any county in New Mexico.

10. At least 120 hours have elapsed since the Decedent's death.

B. The Last Will and Testament of Elizabeth Williams Naylor, Deceased, executed May 24, 2011, is hereby informally probated;

C. Guy Markley Naylor is informally appointed as Personal Representative of the Estate of Elizabeth Williams Naylor, Deceased, to serve without bond, in an unsupervised administration;


D. Letters Testamentary shall be issued to Guy Markley Naylor, upon qualification and acceptance.
