The Presiding Disciplinary Judge ("PDJ") received a copy of an Order Directing Service and Fixing Time for Response and Reply from Arizona Supreme Court (the "Court"), filed July 27, 2026 ("Court's Order") regarding Respondent Gingras' July 22, 2026 Petition for Special Action ("Petition").
